The college has been able to attract many students from far flung areas as well. At present, the college is situated at Yumnam Huidrom in Wangoi Assembly Constituency which is at a distance of 18km. away from Imphal city. The college stands on the edge of Heiningsaipat a scenic lake in the rainy season with myriad of lotus flower. The college is affiliated to Manipur University, Canchipur.

DESIGNING YOUR FUTURE

Since the establishment of the institution in 1981 Mayai Lambi College has been trying with all its sincere efforts to provide access to higher education for youths from a particular area, which had been characterised by lack of college for a stretch of miles, upto graduation level following the academic curriculum of the affiliating university, viz. Manipur University, Canchipur.

THE MOTTO OF THE COLLEGE

It is an article of faith for the college that as much higher education as possible should be given to as many people as possible, the college has been giving its students a much more thorough training in mathematics and science and producing many more qualified graduates. Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Statistics, Botany and Zoology are offered in science stream.

The college lays emphasis equally on Arts stream too alleviating the fear of too Effective citizenship in a democratic society requires humanistic as well as scientific training, the college emphasizes the importance of the stream with a recognition that its primary function is not to turn out skilled specialists only, but also to produce men and

women capable of responsible and enlightened citizenship. In the Arts stream-Economics, Education, History, Geography, Political Science, Philosophy and Physical Education the main branches of Social Sciences are offered in the institution.

Among the languages and literature, the college offers English and Manipuri. All the subjects in Arts and Science stream, except in Physics & Chemistry, have Honours levels courses. In addition to the teaching programme of the courses, the college provides facilities for National Service Scheme, Art & Culture and Sports & Games. Annual Freshers' Social Meet, Literary Meet and Inter House Debating Competition are held in grand manner.

FACILITIES

1. LIBRARY

The college has a well equipped library with adequate books, reference books, journals, Magazines, Newspaper etc. The University Grant Commission alone earmarks Rs. 2.5 lakhs for the college in every plan period for purchase of books and journals. The Government of Manipur has sanctioned Rs. 10 lakhs towards purchases of books & equipments for the College for the academic session 2015-16. The grant from UGC and college fund enables the college to stock its library with latest books, publications and encyclopedia keeping in pace with the libraries of other institutions. The library has 6876 text books and 2750 journals and references, the students of the college are provided with the facilities of getting photo copies of relevant study materials and information at nominal fees. Semi automation of library is going on.

HOSTEL

Hostel facilities for the girls in the college is available in the college campus. For the Girls' Hostel in the college campus has been constructed with the financial assistance for the University Grants Commission

2. SPORTS

Keeping in the view that the state emerged as a power house sports of the country and the sports persons are being given preferential treatment in the employment sector, the college has been promoting Games & Sports both Indoor and Outdoor. Physical Education department of the college provides extensive facilities to the students in various Sports and Games both indoor and outdoor.

Having groomed a number of sports persons of the State at National and International status during the last couple of years, the college proudly rejoices for its contribution to the fields of games and sports. The students can avail of the facilities of taking part in the Annual Sports Meet of the college and Inter College Tournaments and other sports events of the state. University Inter College under the sports Committee of the affiliating University.  - ⇒ A Co-opted teaching staff member belong to SC/ST wherever applicable
- There shall be no quota system in admission for VIP/Principals/Students union etc. under any circumstances.

FROM THE ORDINANCE OF MANIPUR UNIVERSITY CANCHIPUR BACHELOR OF ARTS AND BACHELOR OF SCIENCE

There shall be a six-semester (three-year) course of study leading to the award of Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree. Each semester shall consists 90 working days.

Eligibility

A student who has passed 10+2 examination of council of Higher Secondary education, Manipur or equivalent examination recognised by Manipur University is eligible for admission to B.A./B.Sc. course. A student must complete the course within a continuous span of ten semester from the initial admission.

- Attested copies of the Mark Sheet of H.S.L.C & H.S.E of Equivalent Exam passed.
- Provisional Certificates of the H.S.L.C. of Equivalent Exam, passed.
- Income Certificate from authority concerned.
- Caste/Tribe Certificate for SC/ST candidates and Certificate for DOB.
- For physically Challenged candidates, a certificate from a doctor of the civil Hospital/Medical College showing the nature of handicap and also to the effect that such disability will not hamper in pursuing the course of study.
- Three passport size photographs (recent)

CURRICULUM OF DEGREE COURSE

There shall be a three-year course of studying comprising of 6(six) semesters leading to the Bachelor of Arts/Science Degree.

A student for Bachelor of Arts/Science Degree shall have to offer the following subjects.

- General English/Major Indian Language (Manipuri)
- Three Elective Subjects.

The Honours subject shall be one of the Elective subjects offered in the previous semesters.

N.B. : Details of subjects combinations available in the college in B.A/B.Sc. courses are indicated in the application form for admission.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION OF CANDIDATE

1. Incomplete application forms shall be rejected.
2. All admission shall be granted provisionally.
3. Original Marks Sheet of the qualifying examination should be produced at the time of counselling for admission.
4. Documents once submitted along with the application form shall not be returned.
5. Admission fee once deposited in the college account shall not be refunded in any circumstances.
6. In case of any false information/omission detected in the verification of certificates /documents of a candidate after admission to a course, the College Authority has the right to cancel such admission at any stage.
